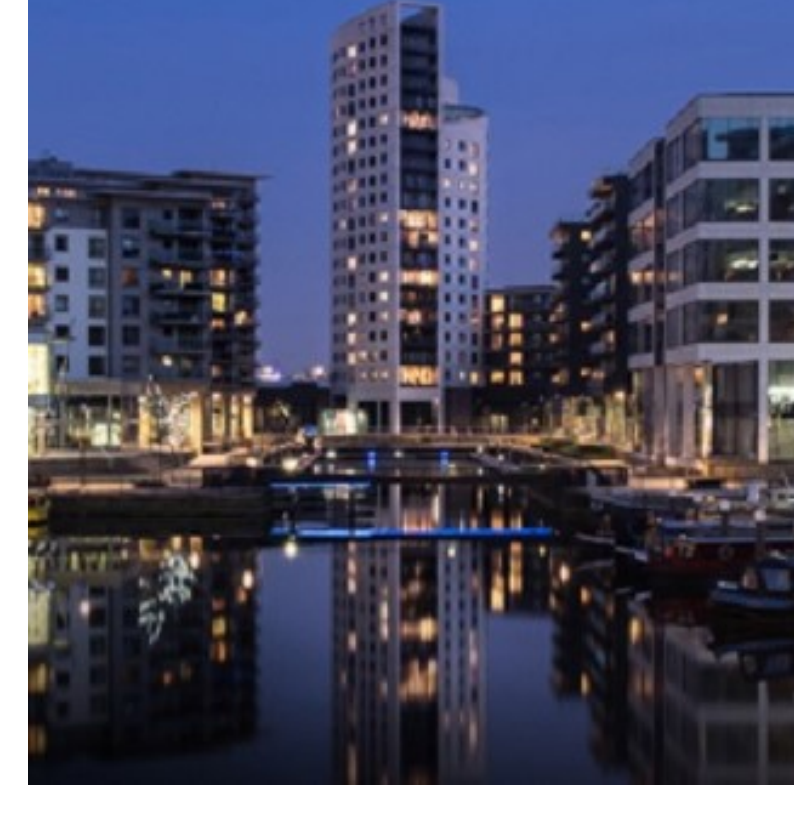
Only You: God's Own Country star returns in romantic drama

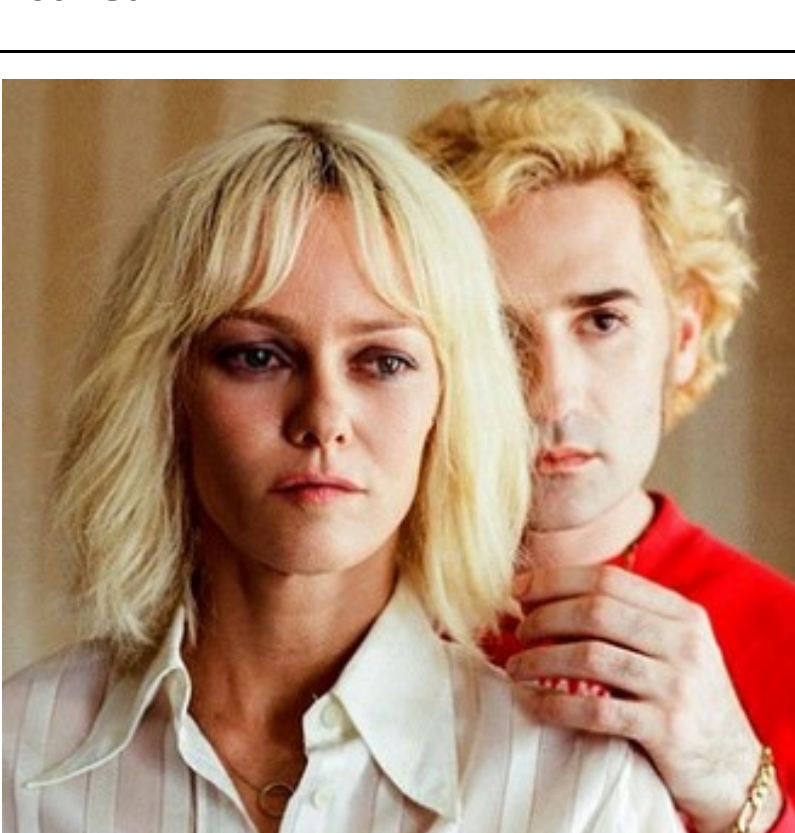
