Diego Maradona: Documentary portrait of a controversial football legend

Diego Maradona was a footballing genius, celebrated for his stellar tenure with Napoli and known for his huge charisma. A new documentary by Asif Kapadia, Oscar-winning director of Amy and Senna, stories Maradona's controversial career, drawing on over 500 hours of unseen footage from Maradona's personal archive.

Like Kapadia's documentaries about Amy Winehouse and Ayrton Senna, the film explores the relationship between exceptional talent and a troubled personal life. 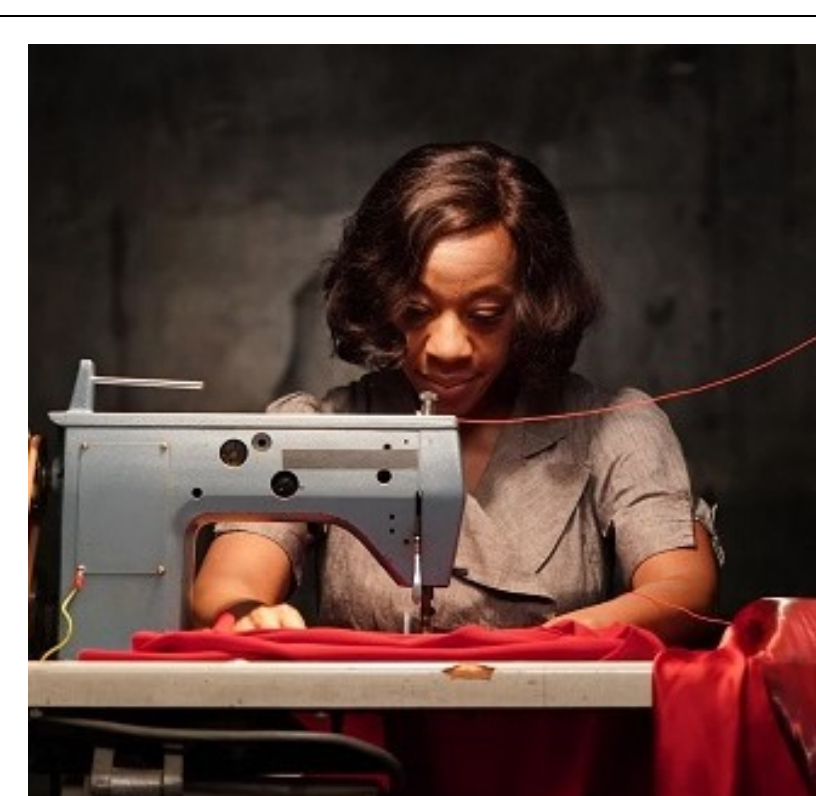
LIFF Presents: Nick Cave - The Road to God Knows Where

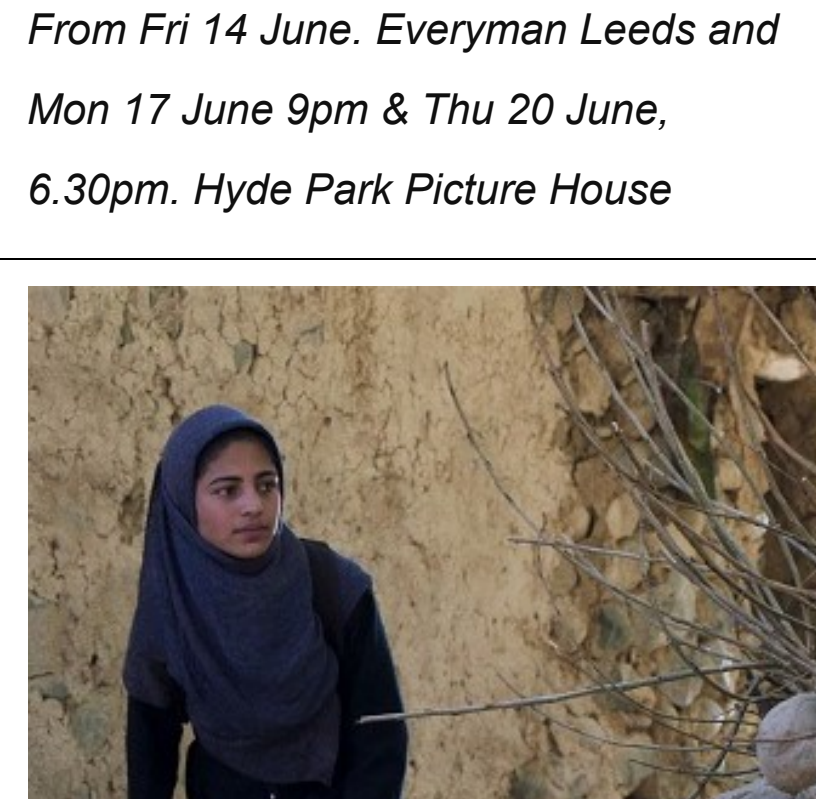
Thunder Road: Jim Cummings' unravelling cop comedy

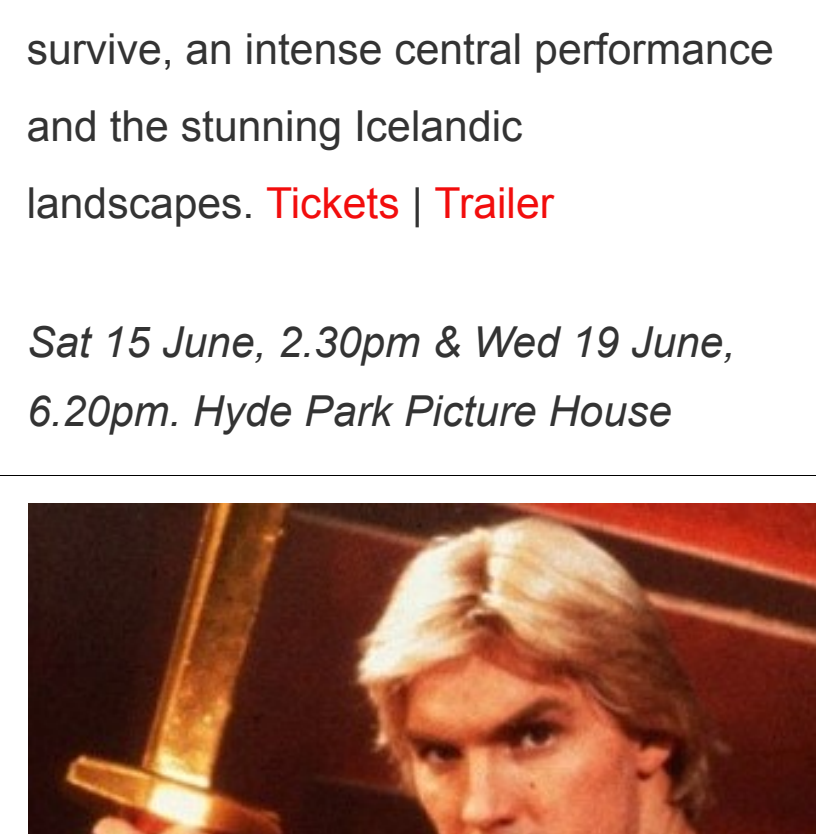
Arctic: Mads Mikkelsen stars in gripping survival thriller

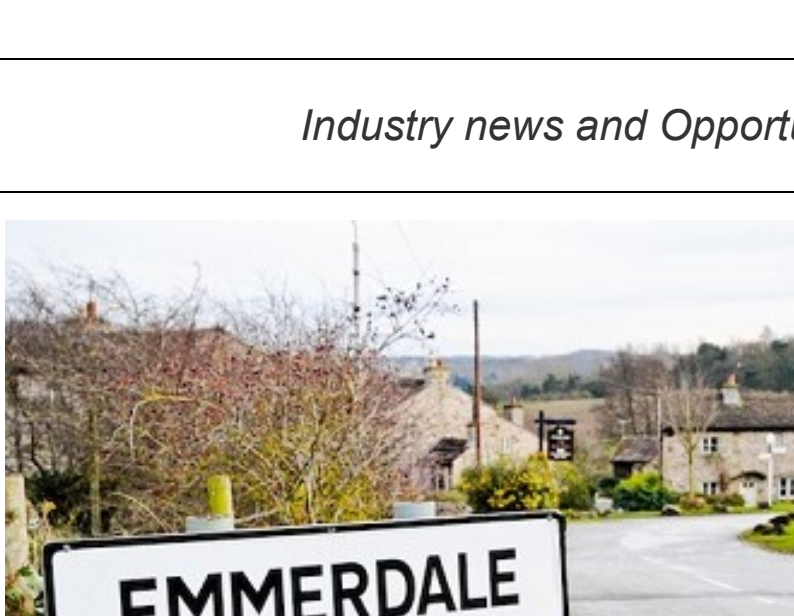


Creatures of the Night: The Wicker Man (Summer Solstice Screening)

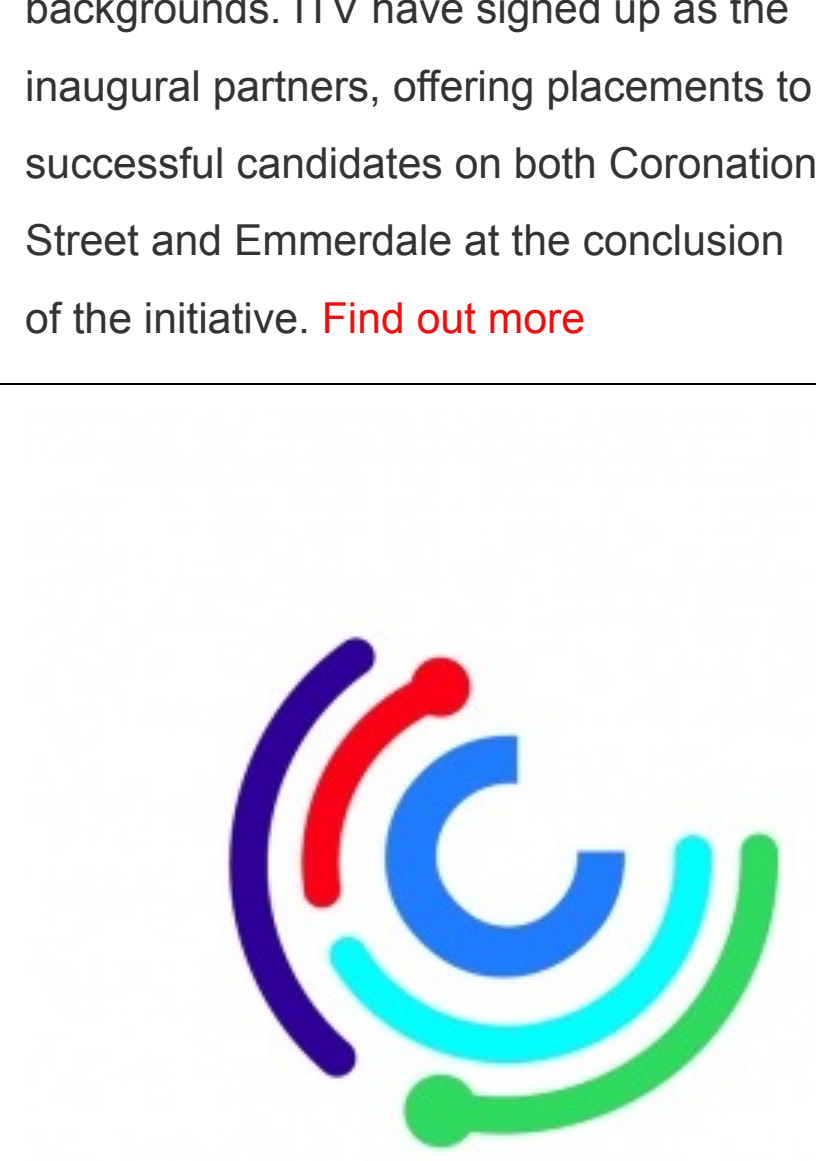


ITV and ScreenSkills join forces on new social mobility initiative
