## Quentin Tarantino's Tinseltown comedy Once Upon a Time in Hollywood

A new film from writer-director Quentin Tarantino is always a landmark moment in the cinema year and the dazzling black comedy-thriller Once Upon a Time in Hollywood doesn't disappoint. An incredible ensemble cast led by Leonardo DiCaprio and Brad Pitt, and also featuring Margot Robbie, Al Pacino and Bruce Dern, animate a freewheeling tale of frustrated ambition on the fringes of Tinseltown in the late 60s.

Washed up TV star Rick Dalton (DiCaprio) and his longtime stunt double Cliff Booth (Pitt) are on the lookout for a big break to relaunch their careers in an industry they hardly recognise anymore. They are excited to discover their new neighbour is star Sharon Tate, but there are dark rumours of a sinister cult led by Charles Manson.
